Insurance and Poverty³

Uninsured under 65 years of age who are **under 138%** the poverty line. These individuals would be eligible for Medicaid if Florida expanded eligibility.



14% of those under the age of 19 are uninsured. This is higher than the state of Florida at 7 and the United States



Approximately 6% of people in Glades County have Medicaid. ⁵

According to the Kaiser Family Foundation, in 2018, uninsured nonelderly adults were over **twice** as likely as their insured counterparts to have had problems paying medical bills in the past 12 months.¹
