# Insurance and Poverty<sup>3</sup>

Uninsured under 65 years of age who are **under 138%** the poverty line. These individuals would be eligible for Medicaid if Florida expanded eligibility.

According to the Kaiser Family Foundation, in 2018, uninsured nonelderly adults were over **twice** as likely as their insured counterparts to have had problems paying medical bills in the past 12 months.<sup>1</sup>
