What is FYSAS?


The Florida Youth Substance Abuse Survey (FYSAS) is a collaborative effort between the Florida departments of Health, Education, Children and Families, Juvenile Justice, and the Governor's Office of Drug Control.

The 2020 survey data collection was almost fully complete before COVID-19 lockdown.¹


