Uninsured under 65 years of age who are **under** 138% the poverty line. These individuals would be eligible for Medicaid if Florida expanded eligibility.

Children Without Insurance³

7.2%

7.2% of those under the age of 19 are uninsured. This is slightly higher than the state of Florida at 7.0% and the United States 5.4%

Approximately 15.5% of people in **Charlotte County** have Medicaid. 5

According to the KFF, formerly known as the Kaiser Family Foundation, in 2021, uninsured nonelderly adults were over twice as likely as their insured counterparts to have had problems paying medical bills in the past 12 months.¹
