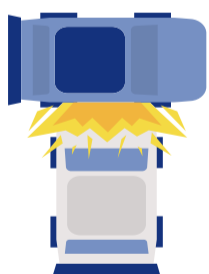
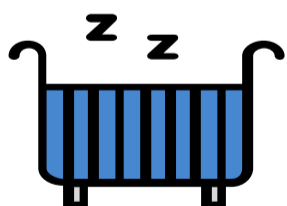

In 2021, the leading unintentional injury that sent seniors (aged 65 and older) to the emergency department was **falling**.

Seniors in Collier County had a **slightly lower** rate of emergency department visits due to falls than the Florida average (3,691.1 vs. 3,955.7) in 2021.²
