

Aging in Hendry County

14%

In 2024, approximately **14%** (5,615) of the population in Hendry County was 65 years and older. Of those, 633 are 85 years of age or older.¹

ACCESS TO CARE



When compared to Florida, Hendry County has more nursing home beds (600.9 vs. 357.5 rate per 100,000) in 2024.²

In 2024 there was **7,264** seniors in Hendry County that enrolled in Medicare³



About **36%** of seniors 65+ in Hendry County are living with a disability.⁴

FALLS



Falls among those 65+ were the leading fatal unintentional injury.⁴



In 2024, the rate of seniors aged 65 and older who visited the emergency department for a fall was 7,622.4 per 100,000, higher than the Florida average (5,587.5 per 100,000).²



SOCIAL & HEALTH FACTORS



About **25%** of seniors in Hendry County live alone. Senior isolation is a major public health concern. This could negatively affect a person's physical and mental health.⁴



The average monthly Social Security income for seniors in Hendry County in 2023 was **\$1,647.00**.⁵



About **51%** of people aged 65 and older in Hendry County live below 200% of the poverty level.⁴



Approximately **30%** of seniors 80+ in Hendry County in 2023 do not have a drivers license.⁶
